

Heartsaver AED

Aim

The Heartsaver AED course trains participants to promptly recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate ventilations and provide early use of an AED.

In the Instructor-led course, students participate in simulated cardiac arrest scenarios and learning stations. Students work with an Irish Heart Foundation Instructor to complete CPR skills practice and skills testing.

Course Content

- Updated science and education from the new 2020 AHA Guidelines Update for CPR and ECC
- Instructor-led, hands-on class format reinforces skills proficiency
- Emphasis on high-quality CPR including AED use
- Video-based course with real world scenarios
- This includes the use of all equipment available to the learners.
- The tutor examines the performance of each learner throughout the practice and gives immediate feedback on their technique as well as reinforcing the successful aspects of their technique.
- At the end of the programme the tutor submits course records for approval and certification.
- Irish Heart Foundation/American Heart Association Heartsaver AED certificates are issued to all successful participants.
